



Tranmere Park Primary School Personalisation of IPC

School focus	Explanation
Spoken Language (Orange)	Activities promoting all aspects of spoken language (e.g. group discussion, debate, public speaking etc.) to be included in all topics and clearly specified on plans in orange.
British Values (Red)	Activities promoting British Values to be included in all topics and clearly specified on plans in red. Over the year, aim to cover each Key Concept being addressed: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Democracy• The Rule of Law• Individual Liberty• Mutual Respect• Tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs
Food for Life (Brown)	Activities promoting Food for Life to be included in all topics and clearly specified on plans in brown. Over each year, aim to cover planting, growing, cooking and 1 farm visit & specify which is being addressed in the current plan. **Please see the specific skills that are needed for each year group and ensure they are taught throughout the year. Saved in 'Food for life' folder on S-Drive.**
Artsmark (Purple)	Activities promoting the Arts to be included in all topics and clearly specified on plans in purple. Over each year, aim to cover music, art, dance & drama & ensure at least 1 activity annually is provided by a professional. Specify which is being addressed in the current plan.
P4C/Growth Mindsets (Light blue)	Activities promoting Growth Mindsets & P4C to be included in all topics and clearly specified on plans in blue.
Outdoor Learning (Grey)	One activity at least planned each half term and clearly specified on plans in grey.
Computing (Pink)	One Computing project planned for each half term and clearly specified on plans in pink.
Cross curricular maths (Yellow)	One cross curricular Maths opportunity to be planned each half term and clearly specified on plans in yellow.
Science (Dark blue)	Any extra Science activities that are completed through topic lesson that are additional to Science lessons.
