Admission to High School 2017 – Current Year 5 children

Pupils due to go into Year 7 who will be starting secondary school in **September 2017** will be able to apply for a place between 1 August 2016 and 31 October 2016.

This e-mail contains important information about the application process.

All applications for Year 7 pupils starting secondary school in September 2017 need to be made via the online application system.

Parents can apply for a secondary school place by going to www.leeds.gov.uk/admissions. This site also contains a YouTube video giving parents a step by step guide to completing their online application. The online application form and the video will be available from the 1 August 2016.

Parents will need a valid e-mail account in order to set up and create an account in the online system. Free computer access and help with setting up an e-mail account is available in Leeds City Council Libraries and One Stop Shops. If parents need help applying online for a secondary school place they can come to one of the drop in sessions outlined below for support with their online application.
