Overview of Standards 2015-2016 – Results to be very proud of!

We would love to share some of our pupil outcomes with you from the last academic year.

At the end of last year's Early Years Foundation stage 89% of our children made a 'Good Level of Development'. This compared with 62.5% in Leeds and 69.2% nationally. **These outcomes placed our Early Years results as the second highest in Leeds.**

100% of our Year One children passed their phonics screening check. The Leeds average this year was 79.5% and the national average was 80.7%. **This placed our phonics screening check outcomes as joint first in Leeds.**

Our end of Key Stage 1 SATS results (year 2) were as follows:

These results placed our school as fourth overall in Leeds for the end of Key Stage 2. The number of children attaining the expected standard in reading, writing and maths combined placed our school at fourth percentile nationally.

TRIAL OF EARLY MORNING PROCEDURES

Due to congestion around the school pathways at the start of the school day we will be trialling the following system from Monday 10th October 2016.

ALL children will line up in the playground at 8.50am when the whistle is blown.

PLEASE CAN WE ASK ALL PARENTS TO LEAVE THE PLAYGROUNDS AT THIS STAGE.

The children will then be escorted to their classroom accompanied by a member of staff. This is to encourage independence and to avoid the congestion of buggies/parents/children all using the pathways at the same time.

Pupils should be on the playground for **8.50am at the very latest**.

Once the class have entered school through their classroom door the door will be promptly closed.

Any child who comes into school after the doors have closed <u>must</u> enter school via the front entrance to sign the signing in and out book and stating the reason for being late. This is to ensure they are accounted for in school.

Can parents please ensure that child-minders/grandparents etc that bring children to school at the start of the day are aware of these new arrangements.
