Parents need to apply for a Reception place via the Leeds City Council website. Please note even if you have a child already in school you still need to apply for a younger sibling place via Leeds City Council.

In addition please email Mrs Reeve at <u>victoriareeve@tranmerepark.leeds.sch.uk</u> to enable school to ensure all younger siblings of children attending this school are on the allocation list when it is first issued to school in April 2017.
