informed/reminded that the Health Protection Agency recommends that children (and adults) should be kept away from school for 48 hours from the last bout of vomiting and/or diarrhoea in order to stop the spread of infection. We would be grateful if all parents/carers would follow this guidance – Thank you.

#### **Leeds City Council – Catering Leeds**

Currently Catering Leeds provide a new menu each term in September, January and April. After consulting with schools they are planning to adopt a menu which changes twice per year.
