#### Winter Plan

This week we have experienced a number of mornings where the pathways have been very icy. Under our winter plan we will prioritise the school pathways to be gritted. We will endeavour to grit the main pathway entrance into school from Ridgeway down to the front entrance of school and also grit from the side gate on Ridge Close to include the perimeter path around school. Due to time restrictions it is not always possible to grit the path from the ginnel to Early Years before school starts. Please note it is not school's responsibility to grit the ginnel.

#### **Parent Market Place Event**

Parents are invited to an Open Market Place Event on **Wednesday**, **7**<sup>th</sup> **February**, **2018** after school in the hall from 3.15-4.00pm. This is an opportunity for parents to talk to subject lead teachers about the various curriculum subjects taught in school (Maths, English, History, Geography, PE, ICT, Science, RE, French etc) and the developments planned in each area this year. We hope to see you there.

#### **New PSHE Scheme**

Our new PSHE scheme (taken from Islington primary scheme of work) been implemented over the autumn term through year one to six. We feel the introduction of the new PSHE curriculum has been very positive. The scheme provides a clear and progressive PSHE curriculum. The PSHE curriculum has been divided into 7 different strands:



This term Year2, Year 4 and Year 6 will start their units on Sex and Relationship Education (SRE). SRE aims to support children's emotional development by educating them about relationships and emotions. Lessons will be tailored to the age and maturity of the children.

The lessons and units are progressive and will build upon their learning in Science and PE. In Year 2, the children will talk about the changes to humans and animals through their lives. They will label anatomical parts of the body, including male and female genitalia and the distinguishing differences between boys and girls. In Year 4, the children will learn about growing and changing. They will identify changes through human life-cycles and understand that change is ongoing and individual. They will discuss personal hygiene and learn about the physical changes associated with puberty. They will also learn about wet dreams and menstruation. In Year 6, the children will learn about healthy relationships and how a baby is made.

The school is well aware that the primary role in children's sex and relationships education lies with parents and carers. We wish to build a positive and supporting relationship with the parents and carers of the children in our school through mutual understanding, trust and co-operation.

please be aware that we will sometimes discuss issues around relationships as and when appropriate. We would hope that through open and honest communication, in which parents and carers are fully aware of the whole programme and its benefits, no child is withdrawn. However, if parents request for withdrawal this should be put in writing and discussed with the class teacher or Head teacher.

Please come and talk to your child's class teacher, the PSHE subject leaders (Miss Beestin and Mrs Gibson) or learning mentor (Mrs Martin) if you have any further questions regarding the content and teaching of SRE.

# **Glow Disco**
