Glow Disco

We have decided to change the disco a bit this year, so we are having a glow disco. The disco is created by making the room as dark as possible and lighting it with powerful UV lighting. It includes a spectacular light show with multiple lasers and smoke adding to the effect. The DJ suggests that to get the most out of the neon the children wear white clothing, accessories and bright neon colours which fluoresce under the u.v. lights, socks, laces, gloves, your child could simply use a neon highlighter pen on a white t-shirt and create their own design, this is optional and is up to you and your child if you are feeling creative.
