Remember	Re-tell a <i>Greek</i> myth through a storyboard.	Can you re-tell a <i>Greek</i> myth set in the present day? Think about the characters and the setting you would choose.
Understand	You are a Roman or an <i>Ancient Greek</i> child. Write a letter to the children of the present day, telling them what life is like.	You are a Roman child writing a letter to an <i>Ancient Greek</i> child, talking about your daily life. What does the <i>Ancient Greek</i> child write in response? Write both letters.
Apply	Draw and label a plan of the main tourist attractions of <i>Ancient Athens</i> . Which buildings would you recommend that people visit and why?	Record a virtual tour of a main attraction of <i>Ancient Athens</i> . Include exciting facts and explain the key features and purpose of the attraction.
Analyse	What have the Romans left behind in England? Think about things we still use today that they invented.	Thinking about the local area, investigate the impact the Romans have had. What evidence is there to show that they lived and settled here in the past?
Evaluate	Think about what makes someone a celebrity today. In <i>Ancient Greece</i> , Alexander the Great was considered a hero. Why do you think he was considered a hero?	You are the producer of the TV show 'I'm A Celebrity Get Me Out Of Here!' Can you argue the case that Alexander the Great should be included in the show? Decide whether he has the celebrity status required.
Create	Create a costume suitable for a Roman woman or man; write a brief description of when it would be worn, e.g. a battle costume, celebratory costume or everyday outfit.	You are Roman Senator or Senator's wife and you have been invited to the Emperor's banquet this evening. Design the outfit you will wear and provide a commentary about what made you choose it.
