


# Year 1/2 Homework 'From A to B-Transport & Travel'

| <b>Remember</b>   | Collect transport pictures from magazines. Make a poster with some key facts.   | Describe a method of transport. Draw a diagram and label the parts.  |
| <b>Understand</b> | Research a method of transport that you have not travelled on before and create an information sheet to show what you have learnt. (Remember that this could be transport from around the world!) | How do you get from school to home? Explain the method of transport and draw a map.  |
| <b>Apply</b>      | Stand safely near a busy road with an adult and record the types of transport that pass you. Show your findings on a pictogram or bar chart.  | What modes of transport would you need if you were travelling on holiday to Australia? Are there any other options?  |
| <b>Analyse</b>    | What are the benefits of an electric car? Create a poster to show what you find out.  | Using a map, go on a walk that you haven't been on before. How did you find it? What would you do differently next time?   |
| <b>Evaluate</b>   | Find out about the first bicycle to be invented. How has it changed compared to those we use today?   | Using simple maps or aerial views <a href="http://www.google.com/maps">www.google.com/maps</a> and evaluate whether the route you take to school is the shortest route. If not what is the shortest route? Map it out. |
| <b>Create</b>     | Write and create a song about travelling on different forms of transport.   | Invent your own form of transport. This could be something from the future!  |
