General School Information/Dates

Covid-19

Schools have been asked to remain open throughout the current 'spike' in coronavirus cases and consequent national lockdown. It is now more important than ever that we pull together and adhere to the safety measures we have in place. They are there to protect our children, families, staff, and support the work of the NHS at this time.


Please make sure you are aware if the requirements should you, or anyone in your household, develop symptoms, test positive or be notified by test and trace that you are a contact of someone who has tested positive. A flow chart with the information you need is below. Government guidance now states that you could be fined if you do not follow this guidance.

Government and Leeds City Council guidance to schools states that where an adult or child is experiencing symptoms but is unable or refuses to take a test we MUST treat this case as an assumed positive and put the appropriate response in place.

We have a number of measures in place in and around school to mitigate risk to our school community as much as we possibly can. Please can we ask that you continue to follow our one-way system, wear a mask on site if you are able, stick to your given slot for drop-off and pick-up and that you and your child/children remain 2 metres apart from others not included in your household.

We are absolutely confident that we can continue to keep school a warm, welcoming and safe place for our children and continue to provide a sense of 'normality' at this time. But it will take the combined efforts of us all to make this happen. As ever, we thank you for your support.
