## **Pupil Support Subcommittee Annual Report 2019/20**



### Membership

The Governors on the Pupil Support Sub Committee during the 2019/2020 academic year were:- Kirsten Finley (Co-Headteacher), Alison Hodgson (Co-Headteacher), Marie Stout (Chair of Governors), Robert Fordyce (Parent Governor) and Helen Perry (Co-opted Governor).

### Work completed by the Sub-Committee

Unfortunately due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the School year was cut short and the Sub-Committee were only able to meet for two meetings in last academic year.

### Items to report

The Committee has overseen the introduction of a new Behaviour Policy in School. The previous “Green”, “Amber” and “Red” warning system has now been replaced with a “1<sup>st</sup> Reminder”, “2<sup>nd</sup> Reminder” and “Time Out” system which has been well received by staff and appears to be working well in practice.

School secured PE grant funding of £19,000 which would be used to invest in new sports equipment and kits for school teams to wear. It is also hoped that the money can be used to engage external specialist sports instructors who can visit school both to supplement and enhance Tranmere Staff’s PE teaching skills.

Robert Fordyce came into School and carried out safeguarding interviews with a selection of children across different year groups.

The Sub-Committee was also involved in discussing the School’s COVID-19 response and considered the Department for Education’s guidance as to what measures should be put in place within Schools to ensure continuity of education and the safety and wellbeing of both pupils and staff.

The Sub-Committee looks forward to resuming its work in the 2020/2021 academic year.
