Remember	Learn some facts about a famous nurse from the past.	Research Jennifer Worth, a famous midwife from the 1950s. Watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=- 1484EuazNI and recall facts about her. Be creative!
Understand	Why do we remember the life of Florence Nightingale?	What was hospital life like in the Crimean War? Compare hospitals then to hospitals now. Are there any similarities/differences?
Apply	Take on the role of Mary Seacole and ask an adult to interview you about your life. Try to use expression to make the interview really interesting!	Learn some basic first aid and create a video to demonstrate your understanding.
Analyse	What does a nurse do? Find out about the role of a nurse and show your findings however you wish!	Was Mary Seacole right to spend her own money helping soldiers? What did she spend her money on?
Evaluate	Eating a healthy diet is one way that we can keep our bodies well. Design a healthy meal using foods from the five food groups. You could even make your meal!	Florence Nightingale is famous for her contributions to nursing during the Crimean War. Less people have heard of Mary Seacole. What did she do that was so important? Why should we remember her?
Create	Create a model of your own hospital. What will you include to ensure that the patients are well taken care of?	Florence Nightingale was given an award by Queen Victoria for her services to the soldiers. Design your own award for our NHS staff for their services during the coronavirus pandemic.
