<b>Apply</b>	Make a holiday leaflet about England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland which would encourage people to come and visit.	Interview three adults and find out their favourite places in the United Kingdom and why they like them.
<b>Analyse</b>	Draw a map of your local area from memory. How much can you remember?	Can you find out three facts about your local area?
