<b>Remember</b>	Find out about the history of the teddy bear.	Choose a toy. Can you identify the materials that it is made from?
<b>Understand</b>	Play with a range of your own moving toys. Create a fact file to show how they work.	Draw a labelled diagram of a moving toy. Can you label the different parts?
<b>Apply</b>	Play a board game with your family and follow the rules carefully. Present your game to the class.	Use construction materials e.g. K-NEX, Lego, Duplo etc to build a model. Take a photograph of your design.
<b>Analyse</b>	Visit a toy shop. Make a list of your favourite toys.	Find out what toys your family liked best when they were young. Present your findings in your own way.
<b>Evaluate</b>	Create your own toy using recycled materials.	Create your own board game and bring it in for the class to play.
<b>Create</b>	Create a toy shop at home! Give some of your toys price tags. Take turns to be the shopkeeper and the customer. Buy an item and find the correct coins needed to pay.
