<b>Remember</b>	Re-tell a Greek myth. For example, this could be presented via a storyboard, comic strip or recorded role-play.	Who were the Mighty Mycenaeans?
<b>Understand</b>	You are an Ancient Greek child. Write a letter to the children of the present day, telling them what life is like.	How does life in Ancient Greece compare to your life in Leeds today?
<b>Apply</b>	Create an information poster or leaflet about the main tourist attractions in Ancient Athens. Which buildings would you recommend that people visit and why?	Choose 1 main attraction from Ancient Athens and record a "virtual tour". Include exciting facts and explain the key features and purpose of the attraction.
<b>Analyse</b>	What impact have the Ancient Greeks had on the modern world? Think about all of the things they have invented!	Looking at modern day Greece, what evidence remains there to show that the Ancient Greeks once lived and settled there?
<b>Evaluate</b>	In Ancient Greece, Alexander the Great was considered a hero. Why do you think he was considered a hero? Do you think he was a hero? Why?	Make a set of Greek Gods and Goddesses "Top Trump" cards to evaluate their status and power.
<b>Create</b>	Create a costume suitable for a Greek woman or man; write a brief description of when it would be worn, e.g. a battle costume, celebratory costume or everyday outfit.
