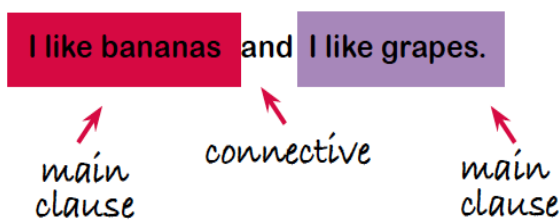
Contracted word forms

Word	+ Suffix	= New Word	What Changed?
hop	-ing	hopping	The P is doubled
race	-ed	raced	Silent E is dropped
happy	-ly	happily	Y changed to I
leaf	-es	leaves	F is changed to V
goose		geese	Irregular plural

Subordination

Main clause + subordinating conjunction + subordinate clause.

I had to wash up even though it wasn't my turn!

I was late for school because my bike had a flat tyre.
